Agapanthus Apartment

We would like to fulfil that dream by offering you a warm and friendly welcome to 'Agapanthus' our spacious self catering accommodation comprising the first floor of our home on St. Mary's, ideally situated to explore the magical Isles of Scilly.

Being on the first floor, Agapanthus' open plan living space has superb views to both the west and east of

St. Mary's enabling you to enjoy a beautiful panoramic vista westward to the harbour and the wide Atlantic Ocean and eastward over open countryside. The house nestles within a landscaped garden where visitors are encouraged to enjoy the tranquil setting of the seating and alfresco dining areas set amidst the exotic plants and flowers.

Located just outside of Hugh Town in the pleasant and peaceful hamlet of Porthloo and within easy reach of beaches, places to visit and the island's many amenities, the quality and comfort of our accommodation together with the relaxed and friendly atmosphere provide the ideal base from which to enjoy a memorable stay on these beautiful islands.



Accommodation

The spacious and comfortable living space comprises two twin sofas, a coffee table and corner display unit. A flat panel colour television, radio, books and games together with literature on local places of interest are provided for your relaxation and enjoyment. Complimentary broadband internet access is available.

The modern beechwood kitchen area is well equipped with refrigerator, large combination oven/grill/microwave, a four ring ceramic hob, toaster, kettle and a generous selection of pans, crockery, glassware and cutlery. The dining area has a large beech dining table and four comfortable high-back dining chairs.

The two comfortable bedrooms are light and airy and furnished to a high standard with generous wardrobe and drawer space. Each room has a colour television, radio/alarm and hairdryer. Bedroom 1 with a standard double bed has sea views to the west towards St. Mary's harbour. Bedroom 2 can be made up as a 6' king-size bed or as two single beds if preferred.

Each bedroom has it's own spacious en-suite shower room with a 900mm shower cubicle, WC and hand washbasin. For guests extra comfort we provide a range of toiletries and bathrobes. All rooms have full central heating and the shower rooms have additional large heated towel rails.



The Gardens

The apartment is aptly named 'Agapanthus' as it overlooks a spectacular display of these blue and white flowering plants at the height of summer.

Lovingly created over the past decade following the complete rebuilding of our home, the extensive garden has been transformed from a barren sandy slope into a wonderful haven amid colourful and exotic plants and flowers.

With seating and patio areas incorporated to take advantage of the panoramic sea and country views the garden is a fabulous place to relax and unwind during a stay in our 'Agapanthus' Apartment.

Paved areas and stepped or sloping walkways have been incorporated to interconnect a newly created lawn with shrub and flower borders interspersed with seating to take advantage of the views. The garden is extremely free draining, so prone to drought and very exposed but despite these limitations has an 'exotic' feel to it with unusual shrubs, flowers and succulents normally found in warmer climes combining to provide colour, texture and interest throughout the year.

Extensive shrub and flower borders have gradually been added together with a succulent garden, herb and vegetable garden and a rope walk.



The Isles of Scilly

The Isles of Scilly form an archipelago of five inhabited islands and numerous other small islands and rocky islets and lie some 28 miles off Lands End, Cornwall, the southwestern tip of England.

Designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the islands are blessed with a temperate climate being one of the mildest areas in the UK. Steeped in history, five of the islands are inhabited all offering beautiful scenery, golden beaches, wonderful walks, unique archaeology and abundant wildlife. Coupled with modern amenities and a diverse range of holiday activities, they offer a relaxing and truly special holiday experience.

The Islands are easily accessible from mainland UK via Skybus, the island's own airline. Alternatively, by sea via the islands' own ferry service aboard Scillonian III that departs from Penzance.
